Please note that scholarships may cover either the full course fee or 50% of it. The exact amount awarded will be communicated to recipients when their scholarship is granted.

Please also note that scholarships **do not include** travel or any other additional expenses

Applications must be sent by 11.59 pm on 26/05/2026

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Candidates must:

- be over 18 years old
- not be older than 28 years
- have basic computing skills and familiarity with at least one programming language
- have good knowledge of English (B2 or above)
- have a demonstrated excellence in their career (academic or professional)
- be able to participate in person for the duration of the Bootcamp 2026 in Cambridge (UK)
- be able to self-fund travel costs

AWARDING CRITERIA

Applications will be scored according to the following criteria:

- **International experience:** priority will be given to candidates with international academic or professional experience.
- **Academic background:** applicants studying for or in possession of a degree in any STEM discipline (including engineering, computer science, maths, physics or medicine), One Health discipline or Business discipline will be given preference.
- **Professional or research experience:** applicants with a proven track record of relevant professional experience and/or any activity in a research lab, including internships, will be given preference.
- **Motivation summary:** applicants with a strong motivation to attend the Bootcamp as a fundamental stepping stone to their future career or academic endeavours will be looked at favourably.
- **English language:** although we do not require an English language certification, native English speakers or applicants submitting a certification (IELTS, TOEFL, etc.) above B2 level will be given priority.
- **Additional skills:** applicants providing evidence of additional technical skills in STEM/One Health/Business fields (medicine, electronics, robotics, public health, AI & health informatics, digital transformation, etc.), non-technical experiences and interdisciplinary skills (other language, social impact, volunteering, entrepreneurship, etc.) or certifications acquired in any professional or university context will be given preference.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PROCEDURE

The **closing deadline for scholarship application is 26/05/2026**. Applications received after this date will not be considered. Candidates must ensure that they include **all the required documents in English**.

SUCCESSFUL APPLICANTS

- Successful applicants will be notified no later than **12/06/2026**.
- Should your application be successful, you will be asked to accept your place by **17/06/2026**. In case we do not have confirmation from successful candidates by this date, we will offer the scholarship to another candidate.
- All successful candidates are required to pay admin fee by no later than **23/06/2026** and send a copy of the payment receipt to bootcamp@unicampus.it. Please note: candidates awarded a full scholarship must pay an admin fee of €300; candidates awarded a partial scholarship must pay 50% of the regular tuition fee*.
- Successful applicants are responsible for **applying and obtaining a VISA** to enter the UK (if you hold an EU Passport you do need a visa). Please refer to this website for further information: <https://www.gov.uk/check-uk-visa>.
